MACN NIGERIA IMPACT SURVEY

Action required: Members are invited to consider the invitation from MACN to participate in a Nigeria impact survey.

The Maritime Anti-Corruption Network has launched an anonymous Impact Survey to assess the impact of MACN efforts and to better understand the evolving situation in Nigerian ports and terminals. Please share this questionnaire with your members for their vessels as their input is of great value in this assessment.

Since 2012, MACN has worked to improve the operating environment in Nigerian ports and terminals. This has included the harmonization of port clearance procedures (SOPs) and the implementation of the Grievance Reporting Mechanism for escalation of disputes relating to corrupt demands. Both of these tools are available through the Port Service Support Portal (PSSP) hosted by Nigerian Shippers Council.
