**UPDATED ANTI-PIRACY GUIDELINES ON GULF OF GUINEA REGION -
MTISC GOG WEBSITE**

Action required: Members are advised that the MTISC GOG website is yet to be launched, but that the Centre itself is fully operational and ships in the region are strongly advised to report to it.

Members are advised, that due to apparent technical difficulties, the Maritime Trade Information Sharing Centre for the Gulf of Guinea (MTISC GOG) website referenced in the 'Guidelines for Owners, Operators and Masters for Protection Against Piracy in the Gulf Of Guinea Region' (circulated with PRESS(14)26) is yet to be launched. However, the MTISC GOG itself is fully operational and it is strongly recommended that ships operating in the region should report to the Centre by phone or email, using the contact information provided in the industry guidance.
